She served as Prof and Head of Higher Education and Education Policy Departments of National University of Educational planning and Administration, New Delhi. On academic assignments she has travelled to different parts of the world like USA, U.K., Australia, Middle East, Canada, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Singapore, Hongkong, Bangkok and other countries. Her contribution to Higher education in India thru MHRD, UGC, AICTE, NCTE, NIOS, DEC, IGNOU, and other international agencies such as UNESCO, CIEC, DFID ESCAP, UNICEF, and State Government of Karnataka and other states is well established.


